1. What was your initial reaction to the members of Metallica? Ultimately, who did you relate to the most: James, Lars or Kirk? Why?
2. What relationship in your life feels stuck? When did you realize that you were stuck? How long do you think it has been that way?
3. Do you find yourself wanting to control how the other person relates to you?
4. Adam and Eve did not take responsibility for themselves in Genesis 3. How does accepting responsibility for your role change how you think about all of your relationships? What part(s) do you need to "own" in your stuck relationship?
5. At the end of this process, the members of Metallica found a new and better way to work together and love each other. Read John 15:12. What gives you faith that God will lead you into a new and better way of loving in your relationships, especially the "stuck" ones? Where do you look for the strength to keep trying?
