(Aaron and Hur)

Who can we thank for family to help us? (God)

WEEK 4
Lots of people help Nehemiah rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.

Nehemiah 1-6

Who helped Nehemiah build the wall?
(His neighbors/friends)

Who can we thank for friends who help us?
(God)

WEEK 5
We can praise God with singing, dancing, and making music with instruments. God is good!
